TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The school shall provide tuition in accordance with the New Zealand Ministry of Education Code of Practice for the Recruitment, Welfare and Support of International Students.
2. The Parent / Caregiver / Agent of the student irrevocably appoint and authorise the Principal of The School or such other person that may be appointed by the Principal to:
 - (a) Receive information from any person, authority or corporate body concerning the student including but not limited to medical, education or welfare information.
 - (b) Provide consents in respect of any activity carried out by and authorised by The School.
 - (c) Receive financial information relating to the student including Bank account, debts or income of the student while in New Zealand.
 - (d) Provide consents that may be necessary to be given on the student's behalf in the event of a medical emergency where it is not reasonably practical to contact the Parent / Caregiver / Agent.
3. The legal responsibility and legal guardianship of the student shall remain with the Parent / Caregiver / Agent who shall be ultimately responsible for the important decisions for the student while she/he is in New Zealand.
4. The School shall do its best to ensure the safety, health and well-being of the student but shall not be liable for damage or harm caused to the student or the student's property arising out of the student's accommodation arrangements or while attending the school or outside of school hours.
5. The Parent / Caregiver / Agent agree that the student will abide by such school regulations as are currently in force including those which apply to homestay accommodation situations. The School retains the right to amend these regulations as it sees fit for the safety or wellbeing of students.
6. The Parents / Caregiver / Agent must immediately advise The School of any changes of address, telephone / fax numbers or home circumstances.
7. The Parents / Caregiver / Agents acknowledge that they do not have a permanent place to live in New Zealand and that they will immediately inform The School if it is their intention to visit New Zealand at any time when the student is receiving tuition in New Zealand.
